Since those meetings, the CPAG has interviewed town and county functionaries to get information on what is working and what needs work in New Baltimore. Building on what people said at the meetings and in those interviews we now want to get input from many more people - including you.

As you fill out this survey, think of the Town as you would like to see it. Close your eyes, and when you open them, think of what you would like to see - and what you would not. The Advisory Group will use your input to develop recommendations to present to the Town Board and the public that will help shape the future of our Town.

*We know that change will happen, but we now have an exciting opportunity to help shape the comprehensive plan that will guide the town as it changes. **This is one of the most important things you can do.** Maybe you can't change the world, but you can have a say in the things that could change your town, for better or worse.*

Responses from the survey will be summarized and described at one or more Town meetings – dates and times will be announced when summary of results is complete. Results will then be submitted to the Town Board, along with recommendations for the next steps in planning for New Baltimore.

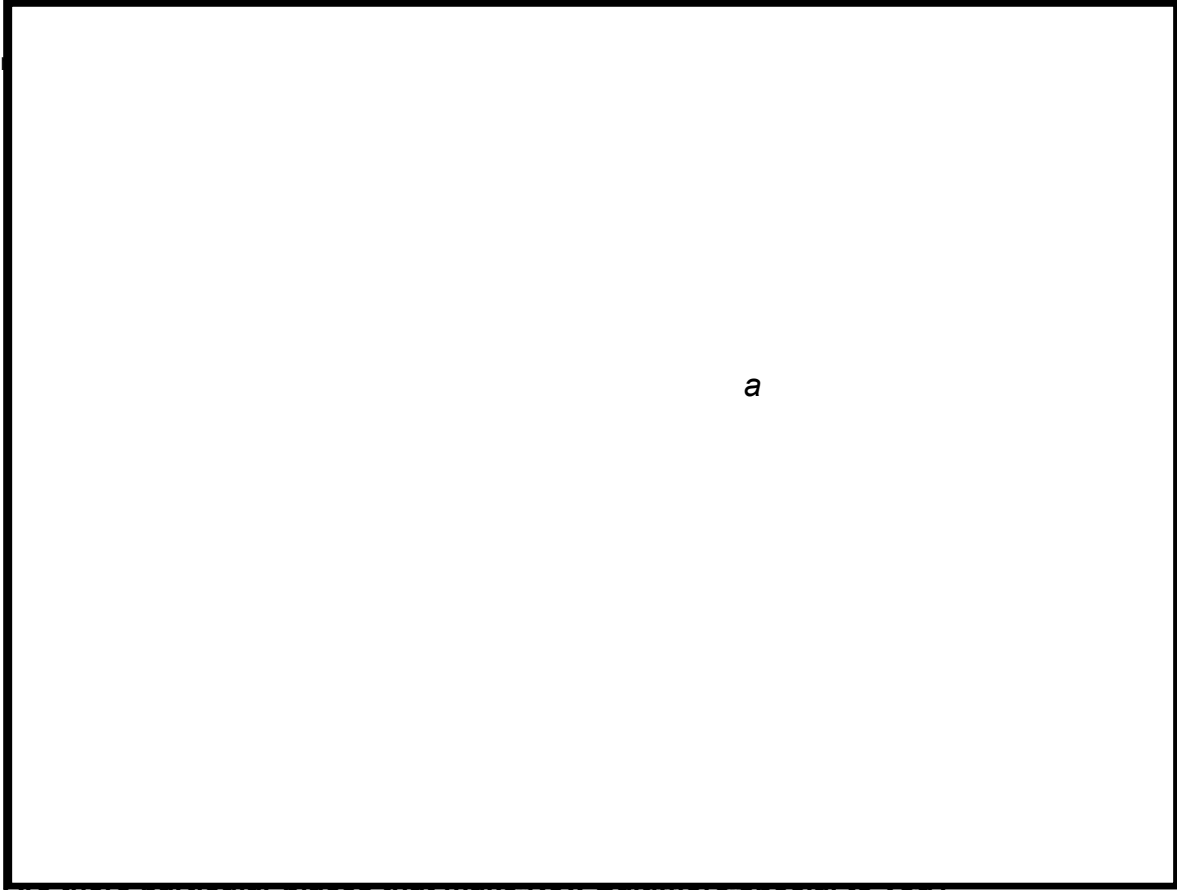
