**Supervisor Dellisanti:** The Proposed Local Law 1, I’m going to discuss the minimum income limits and property tax exemption and read:

<u>Maximum Income Limit</u>	<u>Property Tax Exemption</u>
\$26,500	50%
\$26,500.01-\$27,499.99	45%
\$27,500.00-\$28,499.99	40%
\$28,500.00-\$29,499.99	35%
\$29,500.00-\$30,399.99	30%
\$30,400.00-\$31,299.99	25%
\$31,300.00-\$32,199.99	20%
\$32,200.00-\$33,099.99	15%
\$33,100.00-\$33,999.99	10%
\$34,000.00-\$34,899.99	5%

It’s my understanding that this is done every two years.

**Town Clerk Finke:** And follows the County.
