**OPENING OF PUBLIC HEARING for Local Law #2 of 2011**

Supervisor Susan O'Rorke opened the public hearing at 7:30 p.m. In attendance: Councilwoman Finke, Councilmen Byas, Meredith and Norris, Highway Superintendent Jordan, Town Clerk Brooks, and 10 members of the public who signed attendance sheet.

Supervisor stated that proposed Local Law #2 of 2011 is a Local Law Establishing a New Schedule of Real Property Tax Exemptions for Persons Sixty-five (65) Years of Age or Over and Persons with Disabilities and Limited Incomes, it was read at the last Board meeting, the Town typically follows the county in this regard, and this reads the same as the county.

Legislator Jim VanSlyke said that it was not done in two years and probably will not be done every year moving forward. Councilman Byas asked if they would be carrying on with it; answer: it will not be done every year.
